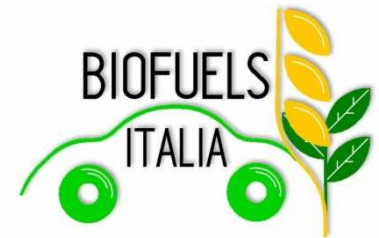

Main aims of the 14th IBS

The overall aim of 14th IBS is to explore the advances, frontiers and applications of biotechnology for a healthier and more sustainable future, and to strengthen relation between industry, research laboratories, governmental agencies, private sector and universities on such issues strategic for the sustainability of human society.

Main features of the 14th IBS

- a. the participation of highly qualified and acclaimed speakers from Academia and Industry from several continents, including developing Countries;
- b. the active participation of industries and SMEs in a large, modern and fully equipped exhibition area;
- c. the active participation of scientific institutions (National Research Council and KBBE Directorates) which will contribute to the presentation of the new FP7 projects and the organization of the scientific and brokerage meetings coordinated by the IBS;
- d. the publication of abstracts on *Journal of Biotechnology*;
- e. the selection of the best papers presented under each scientific section as full papers on international journals published by Elsevier;
