Summary statistics



- 6 updates were received (Denmark, Germany; Italy, Hungary, Latvia, Romania) 8 new schemes
- 57 descriptions have been received in total
- 18 countries,
Austria, Belgium (WagrAlim, FlandersFood), Czech Republic, Denmark, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Norway, the Netherlands, Poland, Romania, Spain, Switzerland

Main trends



- Out of the new schemes
 - Experimental development 7 cases
 - Innovation 6 cases
 - Collaborative research 5 cases
 - Networking 5 cases
 - Technology transfer 4 cases
 - Training 4 cases
 - Collective research 2 cases

Scope of research



- Out of 57 schemes
 - collaborative projects with the industry 36
 - experimental development 31
 - collective research 16
 - innovation 32
 - technology transfer 22
 - training 17
 - networking 20
 - innovation infrastructure 7
 - ERA-NET 5

Main trends - applicants



- Out of the new schemes
 - Research organisations 7 cases
 - Companies 4 cases
 - Restricted to SMEs 1 case

National funding schemes



- There are 21 national calls from 9 countries (Austria, Belgium (FlandersFood, WagrAlim), Denmark, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Romania) where foreign partners are eligible, but usually do not receive funding, plus 3 (the Netherlands, Denmark and Iceland) where funding is also possible
- Worth to consider whether there are potential opportunities for collaboration through harmonised submission of proposals in 2 or more countries paralelly to national schemes
- EUREKA: Austria, Hungary, the Netherlands, Portugal, Romania, Spain, Switzerland
 - Not properly exploited opportunities
